ABSTRACT

Before implementing any intervention program for raising basic facilities and standard in an education system, it is necessary to assess the baseline status of those educational institutions which would be covered under proposed scheme. With this objective in view, a preliminary survey was conducted to find out the status of infrastructure availability in 50 government and Private colleges of Indore, the findings of the study reveal that Government and concerning authorities are apathetic towards improving the status of higher education, especially in remote areas of the Indore.
